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SES awarded two new P21 contracts worth £4.5m

Following on from the completion of three mental health facilities in Leicester, Derby and Lincolnshire earlier this year, SES, one of the leading, independent building services companies in the UK, has been awarded two new P21 Healthcare projects worth £4.5 million.

In partnership with two of our principal contractors, Costain and Interserve, SES is responsible for the installation of the full range of mechanical & electrical (M&E) services, including domestic water services, air conditioning, fire and intruder alarms, CCTV and access control switches.

M&E work on Peaks Lane in Grimsby and the Child & Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS) in Sheffield, are underway and expected to be finished by the end of December 2009 and September 2010, respectively.

Jim Marner, Divisional Director for SES, North Division comments, "SES has been involved in a number of health sector projects including PFI, LIFT and P21 schemes over the past few years, and has a proven track record for delivering first class services.

Both new facilities will provide state-of-the-art treatment areas as well as creating a safe, high quality, environment for people with severe mental health problems.

Peaks Lane will provide an innovative new facility which will supply modern, adult mental health care close to the Diana Princess of Wales Hospital in Grimsby.

CAMHS, on the other hand, is part of Sheffield Children's NHS Foundation Trust and will provide an assessment, treatment and consultation service for families, where there is a child with a severe or longstanding mental health problem.

SES is currently working on a number of other health sector projects nationwide, including Broomfield Hospital in Chelmsford, James Cook Hospital in Middlesbrough and, recently completed Kings Mill Hospital in Mansfield.
